

Church of the Nativity Frequently Asked Questions

What are the Parish Office hours?

Monday thru Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

What time is weekly Reconciliation?

Every Saturday from 3:30 – 4:30 p.m.

How do I obtain a copy of a Sacramental Record that took place at Nativity?

How do I make a facility or room reservation?

What is St. Mary's Food Kitchen and what dates does Nativity participate?

Nativity serves the third Sunday of each month. The weekend prior, pans and sign-up sheets are left in the vestibule. Contact the Parish Office, 491.5017, for more information.

What days may I schedule a Mass Intention and how do I do it?

Mass Intentions are available seven days a week. Intentions are individual with the exception of multiple intentions on Mondays at 6:45 a.m. and Thursdays at 8:15 a.m. Contact the Parish Office, 491.5017, to make arrangements.

What is the donation for a Mass Intention and how far out may I schedule an intention?

A donation is not required, however if you wish to make a donation, give whatever you feel appropriate. Mass Intentions may be scheduled 1 year out from the current date.

May I get married at Nativity if I am not a parishioner?

In order to have your wedding at Nativity, the bride or groom must be a registered Nativity parishioner or currently live within our boundaries OR the bride or groom must have an immediate family connection at Nativity, meaning one or both parents being registered with Nativity.
